Qualifications

- Available for Youth Leader training at Incarnation on Monday, June 11 from 6:00-7:30 OR Tuesday, June 12 from 10:30-noon. Youth leaders **must** attend one of those two days, even if you've led before. You must be registered on or before June 4. No walk ins will be accepted.

Responsibilities

- Assist Senior Leaders with leading bible studies and small group service projects
- Spend time with and assist students at afternoon activities
- Work under direct supervision of Senior Youth Leaders and adult leaders from area churches
- Work respectfully and competently with middle school youth, high school and adult leaders and parents and drivers
