

St. Joseph Contract for Summer 2010 Youth Mission Trip; 6th – 8th Graders

This contract was developed to make sure that youth choosing to go on the mission trip really are committed. There are two reasons this is important: First, after a certain date, there are non-refundable expenses that the church assumes. To be good stewards to our congregation, we do not want the church to pay for a spot on a trip that goes unused. The second reason is that preparing for a mission trip – fundraising, team-building, activities, and bible studies – happens for the six months prior to the trip. All participants count on each other to help prepare to be good stewards.

Expectations for participating in this mission trip:

- Participants will help in fundraising for the financial common good of the whole group and for the fun of participating. Participants, working individually, but still participating in a group effort, may have funds credited to them for certain fundraisers. For some fundraisers, St. Joe's middle school and high school mission groups also work in cooperation.
- There are several group preparedness nights and a team-building day for the combined group to get to know each other and prepare for the trip. Participants will commit to being at those activities, with absences being discussed prior to the event with the church youth mission leader. Dates for four gatherings, January-June, will be determined in November and communicated.
- Sign-up is a first-come, first-serve basis and is complete with this contract fully completed, signed and the deposit (\$100) attached. The second payment will be due in February. If more convenient, the deposit and any payments may be made together (ie. with one or two checks, rather than in three installments).
- All participants who are signed up for the mission trip or who are on the waiting list must pay the same deposit (\$100). If an opening occurs, the first person on the waiting list will be contacted. If they agree to the terms of the contract, they will be put on the regular list. If not, they will be refunded their money and the second person on the waiting list will be contacted, etc.
- If, after February 1, 2010, a participant is dropped from the mission trip or chooses to drop out of the trip, he/she will be refunded any money paid **MINUS** the deposit. If another participant takes their place, they will then be refunded the amount of their deposit as well.
- Participants on waiting lists who do not get put on the regular list will receive a full refund of their deposit. Participants on the waiting list can withdraw any time and receive a full refund of their deposit. Once they are put on a regular list, the terms of this contract applies.
- Payments are to be made according to the payment schedule for the trip. Trip must be paid in full before the participant is allowed to go. Payment #3 may decrease in amount based on the funds raised throughout the year.
